Four young girls cowhided a young man in the street at Retland, Va., on Thursday evening, for talking about them.

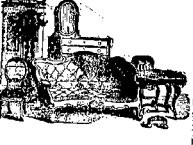
People in Ohio have again stopped talking about erecting a monument over the remains of President Harrison.
