Agricultural.

Selection of Dairy Cows. D. C. Scofield, of Illinois, writes the American Agriculturist:

"Cows of extraordinary milking qualities are found as often among native as among grade and thoroughbred animals. The greatest milkers that have come under my observation was a native. She would fill two pails of two and a half gallons each, or five gallons at each milking, during four or five months of the year.

The best milkers in my dairy, have been, with few exceptions, natives, the grades of Durham and other cattle never excelling. As a general rule, the progeny of these extra milkers become the best cows; and every heifer calf from such should be raised, except it fail to carry the prevailing mark indicating a good milker. This mark is the upward growth of the hair on the inside of the thighs of the calf immediately behind the udder, as high as the hair grows. If it be found running up in a smooth, undivided column, all other things being equal, with good cows and confirmed dairy girls, there will scarcely be a failure. But whatever extraordinary qualities the cow may possess, unless the mark be found on the calf, it is not worth raising for a dairy cow."

There are several other signs indicative of good milking qualities. Smooth and fair sized teats; a large and long milk vein; and sometimes six teats; a yellow skin apparent about the eyes and nose, are indications of sick milk and one of the characteristics of a good cow."

Bloat in Cattle.

From letters addressed to the New York Farmers' Club, we select the following remedies for bloat:

A correspondent from New Hampshire wrote that a neighbor had a steer in a bloated condition from over-eating meal. He tried various remedies, including tapping—but not inserting the quid—to but little purpose. I advised him to dissect three or four tablespoonfuls of cooking soda in water, when turned into the steer, gave instant relief. In less than an hour he was chewing his cud. I knew a good horse cured of the same trouble by the same remedy.

Henry Turner had lived thirty-three years in Jackson county, Michigan, and in that time had cured a great many cattle and horses of bloat or bloat and belly-ache or colic, by giving two pounds of lime or ashes and water, and in case of failure, Dras the tongue and pour slowly. In fifteen or twenty minutes he will be well.

A writer from New Jersey said—Take a stick of wood of sufficient length to reach across the cow's mouth and put a rope to one end, then insert the stick in the mouth, as you would a bit if the mouth of a horse, then bring your rope over the head and fasten to the other end of the stick, drawing the stick up tight in the corners of the mouth. It should be about two inches in diameter, so as to open the mouth pretty well, and you will soon have the pleasure of seeing your cow, or whatever it may be, bloat until it is comfortable, without inflicting it in any way.

A. Fisher, Pike, N. Y.—I have had a good many cattle in the past fifteen years prouled with bloat, but never lost one with it. For each animal take from one pint to a quart of sour milk or buttermilk; add a good handful of salt; pour in a bottle and shake well; give the animal. One dose has always been enough for the time. For colic in horses, two tablespoonfuls maturate dissolved in warm water and given as a drench has saved a number of horses for me.

Dr. Wolf endorsed strongly the last mentioned remedy, saying he had used it for thirty years with entire remedy.
