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The National Centennial. ADDRESS OF THE COMMISSIONERS. The Commissioners in charge of the celebration of the National Centennial Exhibition at Philadelphia have issued the following address:

To our Fellow-Citizens of the United States: The Congress has enacted that the completion of the One Hundredth Year of American Independence shall be celebrated by an International Exhibition of the Arts, Manufactures, and Products of the Soil and Mine, to be held at Philadelphia, in 1876, and has appointed a Commission, consisting of representatives from each State and Territory, to conduct the celebration.

Originating under the auspices of the National Legislature, controlled by a National Commission, and designated as the "Centennial Commission," it is the duty of this Commission to secure the most complete and successful celebration of the first century of our existence, by an exhibition of the natural resources of the country and their development, and of our progress in those arts which benefit mankind, in comparison with those of old nations.

That the completion of the first century of our existence should be marked by some imposing demonstration is, we believe, the patriotic wish of the people of the whole country. The Congress of the United States has wisely decided that the birthday of our great Republic can be fittingly celebrated by the universal collection and display of all the trophies of its progress.
