The Farm and Dairy.

Objects and Workings of Patrons of Husbandry.

From the American Rural Home.

Eds. Rural Home: The order known as "Patrons of Husbandry" is attracting the attention of farmers in almost every State of the Union, and inquiries are made of the objects and workings of the organization. The objects of the order are to elevate the intellectual and moral position of the cultivators of the soil, and also to secure equality and justice in the business relations of life. There has been within the past few years a general complaint of the depressed condition of agriculture, growing out of it, is believed, the unjust exactions of great and powerful monopolies and business combinations, that have become almost universal in the various industries of our country.

The interests of agriculture are paramount to that of any other pursuit, and, employ about one half of the entire business population of the land, and yet the surplus accumulations in the hands of farmers are not as large as compared to that of other pursuits. In our Western States, where nature has furnished the farmer with a soil to be found on the face of the earth, the farmer has grown millions of bushels of grain to feed the starving population of the old world, and also to meet the wants of our populous cities of the East, which has returned but a dollar of profit to the grower, but has enriched and made more powerful for its business population of the land, and yet the surplus accumulations in the hands of farmers are not as large as compared to that of other pursuits. In our Western States, where nature has furnished the farmer with a soil to be found on the face of the earth, the farmer has grown millions of bushels of grain to feed the starving population of the old world, and also to meet the wants of our populous cities of the East, which has returned but a dollar of profit to the grower, but has enriched and made more powerful for its business population of the land, and yet the surplus accumulations in the hands of farmers are not as large as compared to that of other pursuits.

The farmer from his isolated position, and when acting in an individual capacity, is powerless to resist the wrongs of which we complain, but collectively, and when acting in harmony, they may become a power which no party or corporation can successfully array itself against. I trust the time will never come in our country when different parties will be arrayed in part against each other, but the time has come when the farmer, the bone and sinew of our land, must become the victim of rapacious corporations, or he must take his position in defense of justice and equity. He must know his rights, and, knowing them, maintain them. The Grangers are not a political party—political or religious opinions are not to be disseminated through the order; but political action in the direction of promoting our rights and the election of men to office for their betterment, rather than party allegiance, will be their aim. The order will seek to encourage intelligence, refinement and social position, and to qualify the farmer and his sons and daughters to feel their position to be the best of either of other professions. The order has also agencies whereby farmers may sell their produce directly to the consumer, or do so, but no member is required to buy or sell through the grange unless he chooses so to do.

Equity is made of the workings and organization of the grange. At the center of the current new knowledge that there is a National Grange, the headquarters of which is at Washington. There is also a State Grange in each State, which has authority to organize subordinate granges, which are desired to be in every town. For the purpose of organizing, the officers of the State grange appoint deputies, one in each Congressional District, if applied for. These deputies establish subordinate granges wherever they are asked for by the men and four women, which in the recent years has been the case. The number of names on the application may be increased to twenty men and ten women. These are called charter members, and the first officers are chosen from this number to hold their places one year. The fee of charter members are three dollars for men and fifty cents for women, and the deputy is paid a percentage of this fund for his services. Any one interested in agriculture may become a member, after the organization, on being approved by a vote of the grange, and paying the fee of three dollars for men and fifty cents for women, and the deputy is paid a percentage of this fund for his services. The Patrons of Husbandry are a secret organization, which has prejudiced the minds of many staid old farmers against them; but when we consider that agricultural societies, farmers clubs and associations have failed to reach the great mass of the American farmers, or have failed to elevate and improve their condition, but have been allowed to fall into the hands of mediocres, professional gamblers, horse-jockeys and politicians, we see the necessity of something more exclusive, and that have had foundation, reaching every State in the Union, and recognized everywhere in its membership—something that will be a perpetual bond of union between the hardy workers of the soil—that it shall God give to our first parents and the husbandman will be the nobleman in all that adorns and elevates manhood.
