oysters recently described—is by no means new, though probably original or the part of American naturalists. Lon-I don fishmongers have muzzled ovsters o la large scale from a time that is imme-' morial among them, but without wires. as anybody may learn by watching an 'expert in the process of barreling. After the mass of oysters is compressed so as a render the slightest gaping of any one quite impossible he firmly nails down the head of the barrel. Experience proved that oysters thus effectively muzzled may take long slow journeys (as they did in the old coaching days) and be kept fresh and without loss of flavor for two.
