The Hon. Seth Fenner, of East Aurora, made the closing address, from the text:

We want to weed out those farmers who do not know enough to hurt them any, and send them to the cities and villages to become professional men; then those who are left must 'get there," but if they expect to do it as their grand-fathers did, they will find themselves at the rear end of the procession. Only by new improved and advanced methods can they hope to succeed. Mr. Fenner then gave his methods of raising corn, which he said is a child of the sunshine and warmth. 
