Admission Attire Among the Chins.
If no military success has been achieved by the Chin field force, much interesting information has been collected relative to the numerous tribes inhabiting the Chin mountains. Besides the Chins themselves they comprise Yindus, Chimbos, Welchungs and Chimboks. Nearly every tribe speaks a different dialect. From notes made by Lieut. Rainey, commanding the Chin frontier levy, and published by the government, it appears that some of these tribes are almost as barbarous and ignorant as the savages of Central Africa. They wear scarcely any clothes, and the historical fig leaf accurately represents the full dress of some of the villagers. Their dwellings have no furniture, they have no laws, no religion and no government, except an incomplete village system. Medical science and surgery are absolutely unknown. Their habits are repulsively filthy. They, however, display remarkable mechanical ingenuity, constructing wonderful bridges on the cantilever principle. In some tribes the sole arms are small knives and bows and arrows. They are skillful archers, killing tigers and bear at eighty yards. The women of all the tribes have their faces hideously tattooed to prevent their being carried off by the Burmans.—London Times.
