Oldest Pieces of Iron.

The oldest pieces of wrought-iron now known to exist are the sickle blade found by Bolzoni under the base of a sphinx in Karnac, near Thebes; the blade found by Colonel Vyse imb dded in the mortar of the Great Pyramid, and a portion of a cross-cut saw exhamed at Nimrod by Mr. Layard—all of which are now in the British Museum. A wrought bar of Damascus steel was presented by King Porus to Alexander the Great. This roll of unknown antiquity is still pre-Porus to Alexander the Great. This relic of unknown antiquity is still preserved at Constantinople. The Hindoos appear to have made wrought-iron directly from the ore, without passing it through the furnace, an art now lost. Maborato iron pillars made by that system are still seen in India, some of them duting from ten centuries before the opening of the Christian era.

Paper-Covered Bullets.

In consequence of the enormous initial velocity of the bullet in the now Mann-licher rifle and the resulting friction and wear on the barrel, it has become necessary to devise some method preventing both of these evils. The manager of the Government laboratory at Thun, Switzerland, has consequently devised a method of enclosing the leaden bullet in a thin metallic covering, while over this he places a wrapper of specially prepared clenginous paper, which reduces the wear of the rifle barrel to a minimum, without interfering with the course of the bullet.
