W. C. T. U.

The Woman's Christian Temperance Union of Andover meets the first and third Thursday in each month.

The "majority" convention of the National W. C. T. U. met this year in Cleveland, where twenty-one years ago its first convention was held.

BELOVED COMRADES—Twenty one years ago a band of consecrated women went forth to measure off with their own steps the distance between the home and the saloon.

Since we were here the cause of temperance and purity, the woman and the labor movements, have all gone forward by leaps and bounds; the habit of total abstinence is thoroughly respected everywhere.

Since we were here the white life for two—that equal standard of purity for men and women—which alone can make home happy—has become the dominant note in the orchestra in public opinion, and peace and arbitration have lifted their banners on the battlefields of the world's greatest nations.

Since we were here the eighteen states then represented have grown to fifty, and the single National W. C. T. U. of the United States has been multiplied by national temperance societies of women organized under the Crusade impulse of nearly fifty provinces and nations.

That was mass convention; this is delegated, and aside from the officers, represents a woman to each thousand who have this year paid their dues.

Since those glad days of consecration we have marched by a long and narrow way, through a different country, building the road as we advanced, fording the streams, and sometimes we have traversed the deserts of contention and jungles of defeat.

As we march forward, not on the smooth sidewalk of civilization achieved, but keeping in the middle of the dusty road, where better civilization is on the move, lift a flag at the front bearing this legend: "The Lord hath not given me a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of sound mind."
