Mayor Pothier, of Woonsocket, R. I., said in his last inaugural address, "The sale of liquors to children who are sent to the saloons by heartless or unnatural parents is one of the most crying evils—revolting to the sensibilities—and should be stamped out."

Among the churches in which women have been invited to speak are the three best known churches in the world among what are in England called "Nonconformists", namely Spurgeon's Tabernacle, the City Temple, (Dr. Parker's) and Wesley's City Road Chapel.

The eye of white ribbon workers in all parts of the world are focused upon the meetings that will occupy the entire second week in June, including the two Sundays, June 15 and 22. Two hundred pulpits will be open to our work on that day in London and its suburbs. The ablest pastors, who are also reformers, will preach on temperance and the work of the great Polyglot Petition.


