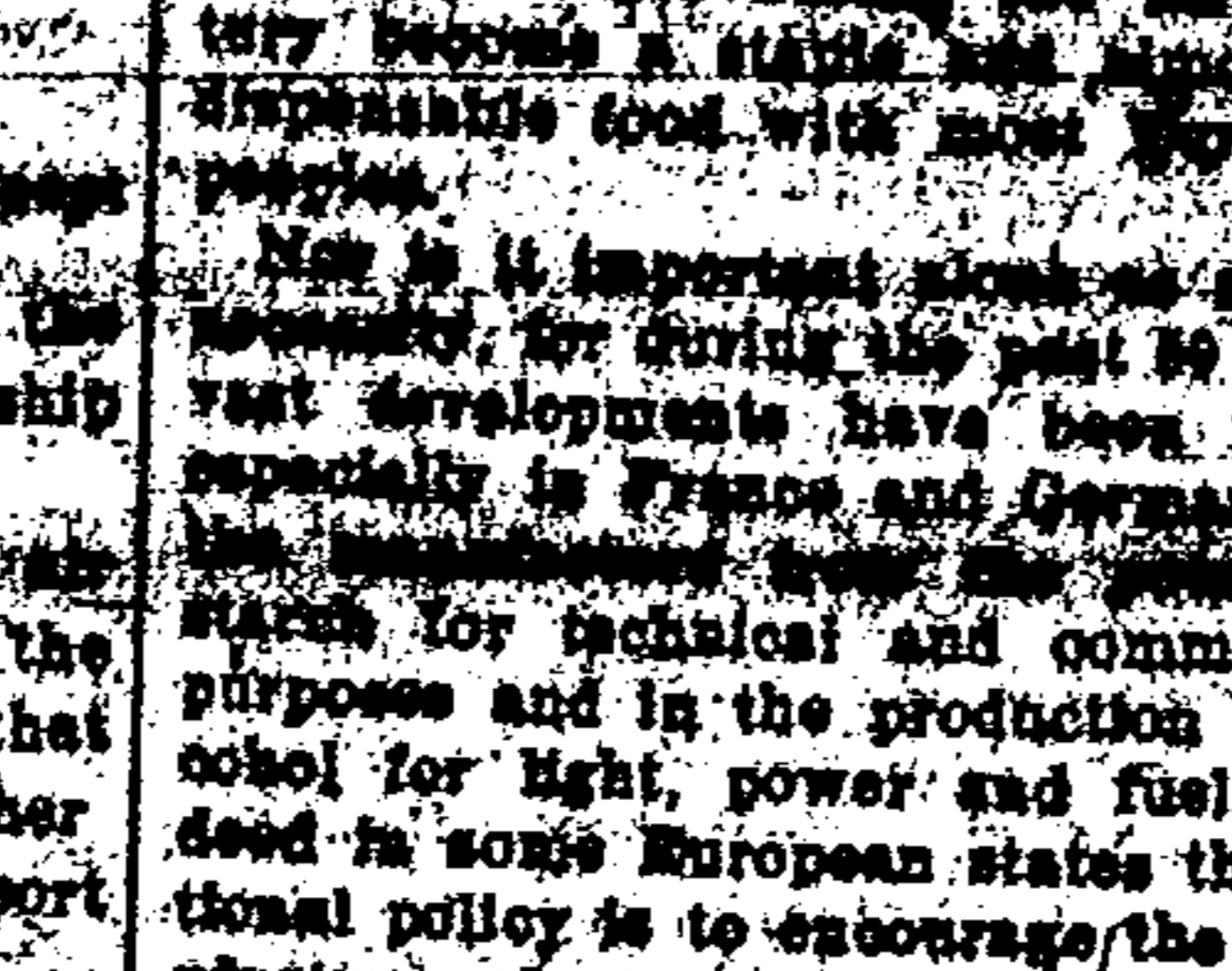

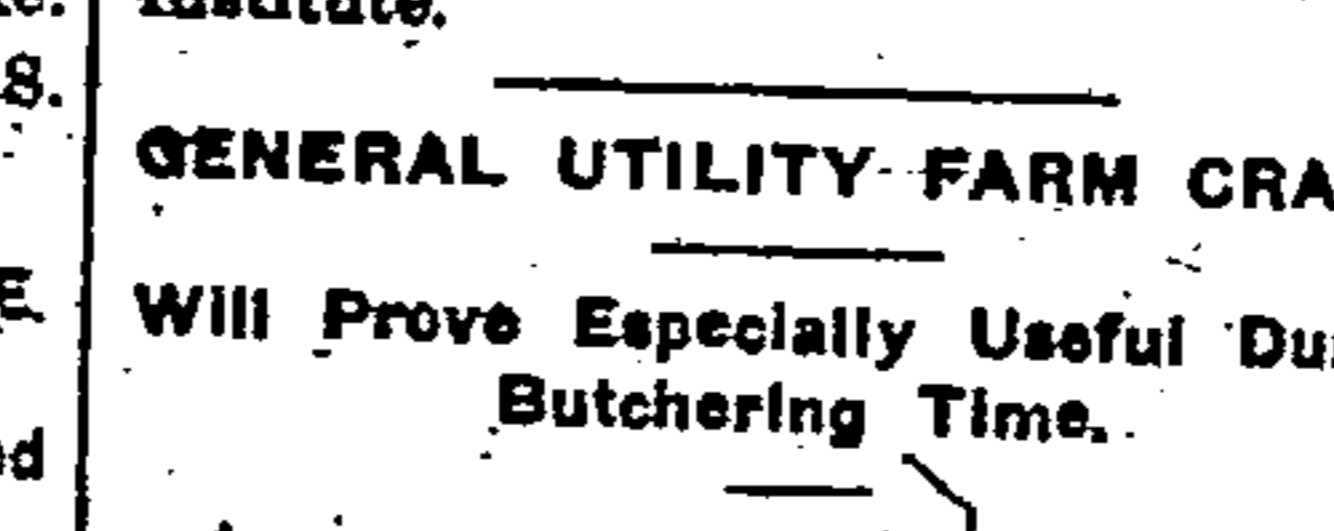


A Home-Made Lifting Crane.

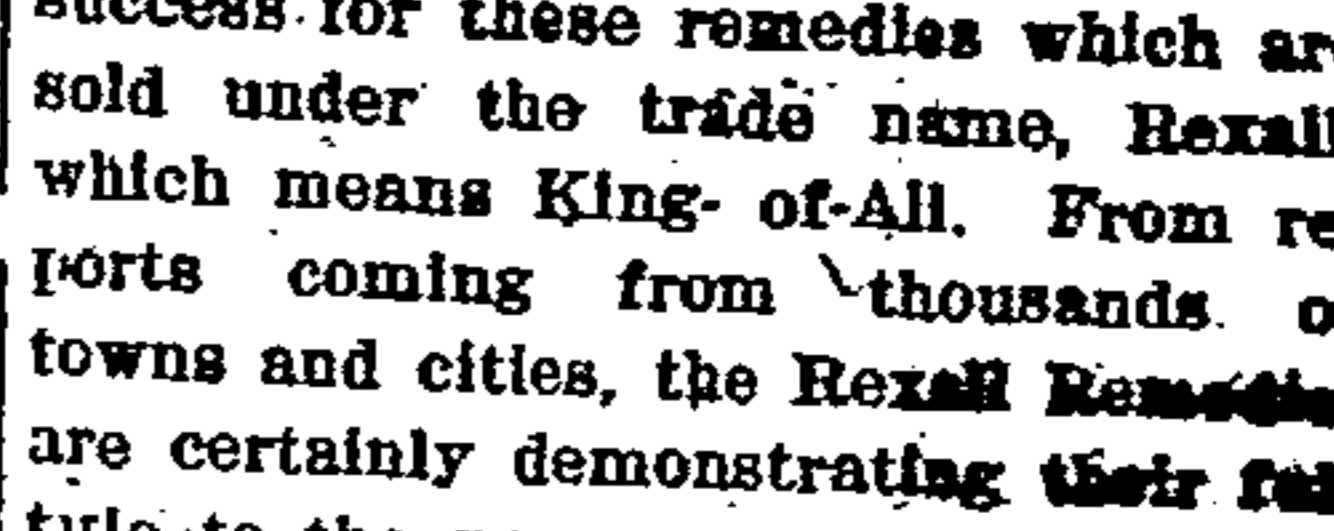
