#### WORK OF ANCIENT DENTISTS

Remarkable Teeth Decoration Shows That They Possessed Considerable Skill.

By far the most transcendent example of teeth decoration which has at present come to light in America is in a skull discovered in 1909 at a . place called La Piedra, near the point on the right bank of the Esmeraldas river where it empties into San Mateo bay. It was accidentally found by Mr. Pinzon and Mr. George D. Hedian, the Cashier E. A. Gamble, of Alfred, latter an American consular agent at Esmeraldas, and was kindly presented by Mr. Hedian for the Heye museum during my visit to Ecuador last sum-J H. Faisant returned Wednesday mer. The skull was seen projecting the skeleton were uncovered, probably having been washed away after the bank was undermined.

The upper part of the skull is in fragments, but is restorable. The skull, slightly deformed, is that of an adult female. The decoration of the teeth is unique and presents a new type of facial ornamentation. Incertain teeth of the upper jaw were almost entirely covered on the outer face by an overlay of gold.
