Plenty of silage and good legum hay will help us to keep the high food bills away.  
 A little bit every day in the garden is better than temporary neglect with later struggles to cultivate it and to keep down the weeds.

Short cuts for the housewife who wants balanced rations for the family can be found in Cornell publication number 112 on food.

Bread and milk are New York's great needs. This points to the possibility of a simple rotation of wheat and clover, enlisted for the duration of the war.

If every farmer will save a few minutes in loading and unloading freight it will mean a large increase of freight cars rolling along the rails on Uncle Sam's business.

Pear packages should be ordered at once.

Strawberries and cherries planted on pantry shelves now will yield a harvest of cheer when the snowflakes whirl again.

On July 1 winter wheat in New York promised a yield of 8,286,000 bushels; oats 42,517,000 bushels. This is an improvement over the estimates made for June 1.

Plenty of shade should be provided for growing chicks. When allowed to range in an orchard or corn field they will not only find ample shade and green feed but will benefit the trees or corn, by destroying bugs and worms.
