**Homespun Yarn**

A sleeping porch is one kind of life insurance.  
A thick layer of newspapers between the springs and mattress of the outdoor bed will keep out cold.  
If the pan for the poached eggs is thoroughly oiled before the boiling water is poured into it, the eggs will not stick.  
Tin or glass containers are best for cereals, flour and spices. Such containers are proof against dust, moisture and insects.  
Lack of lime makes trouble with teeth. A quart of milk supplies as much lime as 28 pounds of beef, 23 pounds of potatoes, or 9 pounds of white bread.  
The vinegar from the jar of pickled peaches or pears may be used for making boiled salad dressing. Such a dressing is particularly good on fruit salads.

**NEW OFFICERS FOR LEAGUE**

The new officers of the Dairymen's League which are being prepared at Utica, New York, will be ready, and it is expected that in a few weeks the main organization will move its headquarters from New York City to Utica. The offices at Utica are being prepared for a large force of clerical help getting ready to handle the pooling of the proceeds of the members' milk, when enough co-operative contracts are signed to make pooling operative. The contracts are coming into the League office steadily and there were at the end of the year 30,208 properly signed and on file, besides several hundred that had been returned for correction and several thousand still in the hands of local officers. When 50,000 members have signed, the co-operative contract and pooling will become operative.

**Good to Remember**

The judge's sentence to serve one year in jail and pay a fine of \$500 came as a result of the investigation into the matter of John Wright in June, 1916.

Wright came home drunk and beat his wife. He left saying he would return and "clean up the place." He returned the next day and attempted to batter down the front door. A shot rang out in the hall and Wright fell dying. When police arrived the woman was hysterical, screaming "I have killed my husband." She was arrested.

The son, Neal, 12, told the district attorney he killed his father. The mother was acquitted. A charge was filed against the boy in the juvenile court.

The son told the whole story to Judge Lindsey who refused to betray the boy's confidence to a jury. The case against the boy is still pending. Judge Lindsey and the boy know who killed John Wright. Neither will tell.

JUDGE LINDSEY NOT TO SERVE JAIL SENTENCE  
Officials Loath to Assume Responsibility of Sending Jurist to Jail  
Denver, Colo., Feb. 3. — Judge Ben B. Lindsey, under sentence for contempt of court, will never go to jail, his friends here declared today. No official of Denver would care to actually take the responsibility of sending the judge to jail, they declared, because of the public sentiment favoring him.

Officials here, asked what action they expected to take as the result of the Supreme Court's decision that it had no jurisdiction over the case, were unable to answer.  
District Attorney Phillip S. Vance said he knew absolutely nothing of the case and could make no statement of what action he would probably take until the court's decision reaches him thru regular channels.
