TWO ECLIPSES WILL BE SEEN One of the Moon Will Be Visible All Over This Section of U. S.

Dr. Benjamin F. Yanney, noted American astronomer, states there will be two eclipses of the sun and two of the moon this year...

April 21, and the second October 16.

Even the casual observer has noticed two conspicuous planets approaching each other in the south-western heavens...

On January 9 they were in conjunction. They will be so again on April 4 and again on October 3.

They were not in conjunction last year, nor will they be so again until after 1922.

Another conspicuous pair of planets, visible in the morning, are Jupiter and Saturn, the former being the brighter and gradually overtaking the latter.

The interesting thing about them just now is that each has begun to retrograde.

They will continue their apparent westward movement among the stars for about a third of a year, when they will resume their eastward march.

Jupiter will overtake Saturn September 14.

The soul of the Grange is manifest in the farm home. It holds that the highest achievement is a life well lived; that the foundation for such a life is the home.

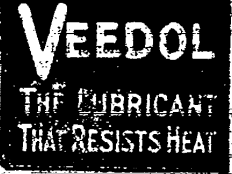
