Visible supply corn 17,745,000 bushels a decrease of 1,355,000 bushels for week. For the week Chicago May wheat up 7% at \$1.46 1/2; May corn 1/4c at 69 1/2c. Chicago July wheat up 2c at \$1.15 1/2; July corn down 1/4c at 61 1/2c. Minneapolis July wheat up 1c at \$1.20 1/2; Kansas City July 2 1/2c at \$1.09 1/2; Winnipeg July 1 1/2c at \$1.30 1/2.

LIVESTOCK AND MEATS: Chicago hog prices declined 15 to 30c per 100 pounds the past week. Beef steers up 2c; butcher cows and heifers 25 to 50c. Feeder steers up 25 to 35c; veal calves about steady. Fat lambs up 25c to \$1; feeding lambs 25 to 50c. Fat ewes gaited 75c to \$1. May 16 Chicago prices: Hogs, bulk of sales \$8.15 to \$8.70; medium and good beef steers \$7.50 to \$9; butcher cows and heifers \$5.25 to \$9; feeder steers \$7 to \$8.50; light and medium weight veal calves \$7.50 to \$9.50; fat lambs \$9.25 to \$12; feeding lambs \$6.50 to \$8.25; yearlings \$7.50 to \$10; fat ewes \$6 to \$7.50. Stocker and feeder shipments from 11 important markets during the week ending May 6 were: Cattle and calves 25,809; hogs 5,935; sheep 9,291. Eastern wholesale fresh meat prices changed but slightly. Beef averaged 50c lower per 100 pounds. Veal, lamb, mutton and pork loins practically unchanged. May 16 prices good grade meats: Beef \$15 to \$16.50; veal \$16 to \$18; lamb \$23 to \$26; mutton \$15 to \$18; light pork loins \$23 to 25; heavy loins \$16 to \$20.

DAIRY PRODUCTS: Butter markets weak; price tendency lower. Consumptive demand has been fairly good but reports that Danish butter has been offered as low as 28 1/2, duty paid, has kept conditions somewhat unsettled. Some interest in storing. Production increasing. Closing prices 92 score: New York 30; Chicago 28 1/2; Boston and Philadelphia 31. Cheese markets show more active trading following declines of past weeks and have taken on more settled appearance. Prices Plymouth Wisconsin cheese exchange but little changed from a week ago: Twins 12 1/2; Daisies and Double Daisies 12 1/2; Longhorns 13; Young Americas 13 1/2.
