These will be sent by the Farm Bureau manager to anyone in the county, who wishes to make consistent and comparitively regular use of this service. It will be given a special trial with a number of farmers in the vicinity of Belmont. It can also be made of just as much use to other farmers thruout the entire county, but until special plans can be worked out, the burden of the telephone charges for this special service will have to be upon the individual. Special arrangements may be made for some communities if desired.
