MARKETGRAM

Latest Price Quotations Received From the U. S. Bureau of Markets Covering Produce and Feeds.

(Washington, D. C., for the week ending, September 19th, 1921.)

Hay Market extremely dull. Receipts at principal markets about 75 per cent of normal. Poor demand except for best grades. Prices at New York declined \$2 during week which made it possible to work some export business to Cuba. Off grade and weather damaged hay selling at heavy discounts at Chicago.

Feed The demand for wheat feeds especially bran is generally dull. Fair demand for middlings in several western markets. Some export inquiry for mill feed reported at New York, Northwestern mills still underselling Westerners mills but on a closer margin. Linsed meal lower. Jobbers at Buffalo offering mill at about \$1 under mills. Spot cotton seed meal firm on the advance in cotton prices but future delivery still at a discount. Mills and jobbers not active sellers for future shipment because of poor outlook for seed. Hominy feed dull and lower. Quoted September 19 spring bran New York \$22.50, Minneapolis \$13, Hard Winter bran St. Louis \$14.50, soft winter \$15. Standard middlings Phila. \$23.50, Minneapolis \$14, Chicago \$17.25. Linsed meal Minneapolis \$39, Buffalo \$43, Phila. \$42.50, 36 per cent cottonseed meal Memphis \$36, Atlanta \$38. White hominy feed St. Louis \$22, Gluten-feed Chicago \$30.15.

Dairy Products Butter markets advanced rapidly early in the week, but are steady at the close with prices 1c to 2c higher than a week ago. Shortage of fancy butter caused firmness, but use of storage butter and reports of Danish shipments on way withdrew considerable confidence. Closing prices, 92c score; New York 44c; Chicago 42c Philadelphia 44 1/2c; Boston 44c.

Cheese markets steady to firm. Most activity at Wisconsin primary markets where a considerable volume of trading took place during the week. Distributing markets dealers less confident of situation. Storage stocks being drawn on to some extent by buyers rather than to pay present asking prices for fresh cheese, although storage holdings show an increase for the week. Prices at Wisconsin primary market September 17: 17c; 19c; Daisies 10 1/2c; double daisies

Livestock and Meats

Chicago and St. Louis. Last week prices for livestock and meats were lower on some of the lighter weights. Better grades of heavy steers and butcher grades advanced 10c to 15c. Lower grade hogs were 10c lower. Butcher cows and heifers unchanged. Both fat and lean hogs unchanged, practically unchanged. Yearlings steady to 25c higher, Sept. 19 Chicago prices: Hogs, top \$48.75; bulk of sales \$6.85 to \$8.20; medium and good beef steers \$6.10 to \$10; butcher cows and heifers \$4.50 to \$9; feeder steers \$5.20 to \$7.25; light and medium weight veal calves \$8.50 to \$13.50; fat lambs \$8 to \$10.10; feeding lambs \$7.75 to \$7.80; yearlings \$5.25 to \$7.75; fat ewes \$3 to \$5.

Fruit and Vegetables Shipments of potatoes increased during the past week and prices in most city markets declined under liberal supplies. New York Giants down 15 to 30c at \$1.35 to \$2.25 per 100 lbs. sacked. New York bulk round whites strengthened slightly in New York, closing \$2.40 to \$2.55 per 100 lbs. Sacked Idaho and Colorado rurals down 40c in Chicago and St. Louis at \$2.50 to \$2.75 per 100 lbs. Prices at Minnesota shipping points off about 15c closing \$1.30 to \$2.

Grain Prices advanced on the 13th on revival of export demand and drought reported from Argentina but reacted on the 14th and prevailed lower the remainder of the week. Main factors influencing decline were weakness in foreign exchange; rains in Argentina the latter part of week; soft milting and export demand, and reports that Canadian wheat and flour were being offered in the United States, duty paid, at about domestic prices. August exports wheat and flour officially estimated 67 million bushels, largest record. This makes total for two months 97,000,000 bushels or about half total surplus of country on basis of other than government figures as total that can be spared. Argentina crop officially estimated 169 million bushels. Visible supply American wheat 46,149,000 bushels an increase of 4,049,000 bushels for week. Visible supply of corn 12,243,000 bushels an increase of 1,009,000 for week. Closing prices in Chicago cash market: No. 2 red winter wheat \$1.28, No. 2 hard winter wheat \$1.27, No. 2 mixed corn \$1.20, No. 2 yellow corn \$1.19, No. 3 white oats \$1.18. For the week Chicago December wheat down 1 1/2c closing at \$1.23.
