We have recently filed with the Pubilc Service Commission certain Changes in the Company's Rules and Regulations effecting NEW and ADDITIONAL GAS SPACE HEATING. A complete record is on file at all offices of the company. For your convenience here is a brief summary of these changes:

- (1) In the future it will be necessary to have written permission from the Company for the use of gas for NEW or ADDITIONAL SPACE HEATING PUR-POSES. Application blanks are available at all offices.
- (2) The Company will maintain a Register of Applicants in the order in which applications are received.
- (3) Written approval will be given to applicants who are eligible under existing restrictions at the time, in the order of filing applications. Such approvals will expire in six months unless equipment for using such gas is connected and ready for use by that time.
- Under certain conditions exceptions may be made for MEDICAL HARDSHIP cases, but written approval by the Company will still be required.
- (5) In event of violations of these rules the Company has the right to discontinue service on ten days' written notice unless such violations are corrected.
- (6) Where the maximum use of gas is less than 30,000 Btu per hour for heating purposes in one dwelling these rules do not apply.
- (7) By order of the Public Service Commission we have been given permission to supply six hundred consumers with gas for NEW or ADDITIONAL SPACE HEATING. However, on large buildings where the maximum heating equipment exceeds 350,000 Btu per hour, restrictions are still in effect.
- (8) Approvals of eligible applications already on file will be made in writing within the next few days.
