



SOCIAL NOTES

Mrs. F. G. Crawford entertained the Entre Nous Club at a 7:30 dessert at her home on Pleasant Ave., Thursday evening, January 20th. Honors were presented to Mrs. Alvin Hoover and Mrs. William F. Joyce.

Announcement of an expansion program was made by Arthur F. Reinking, president of the Turbine Division of Worthington Corp in Wellsville, that is expected to cost well over \$1 million will be started by the Worthington Corp. early in March. Reinking said a wide, high-bay addition will be attached to and parallel to the present structure. It will have more than 20,000 square feet of floor space and stand higher than three stories. Included in the building will be the addition of two heavy duty overhead cranes. This is the 50th year that turbines have been manufactured in this community. Manufacture of the equipment was started in 1916 by the Kerr Turbine Co., which was subsequently taken over by the Moore Turbine Co. Worthington purchased the Moore interest in 1937 and has maintained the plant since. This is the 125th year for Worthington.

The Forpest Brown family near Angelica lost some clothing and other items in a blaze which called out some 15 Angelica firemen at 10:30 a. m. last Wednesday. Chief Richard Sortore said flames erupted at the top of the cellarway and burned through the cellar door resulting in considerable smoke and heat damage throughout the house.

Allegany County maple sugar growers heard talks by Professor Alex Dixon and Fred Winch, both of Cornell University at a luncheon meeting in Belmont Grange Hall last Tuesday. A highlight of the meeting was the presentation of the Tree Farm Award to two Andover farmers, a father and son. Clifford and Carroll Burdick of Railroad Valley, Andover, were the recipients of the award.

Conversion of the interior of the Town and Village Hall in Belmont as the new home for Allegany County Extension Service is expected to be completed by May 1. This was announced at a joint meeting of Amity Town Council and Belmont Village Board after the lone bid for construction materials for the work was accepted. Cost of renovation is being met jointly by both the town and village. The Extension Service was asked to vacate its present location in the basement of Belmont Courthouse to make way for permanent personal registration equipment. To be moved to the town and village hall will be departments of 4-H Club Agent Lawrence A. Dedrick, Agricultural Agent Charles W. Hebblethwaite and Home Demonstration Agent Mrs. Mary Lou Luckey.
