

**Bids Sought On Soil Tests For Southern Tier Expwy.**

Albany — J. Burch McMorran, State Superintendent of Public Works, announced recently that sealed bids will be opened here February 24 for soil investigations along 38.7 miles of the future route of the Southern Tier Expressway in Cattaraugus and Allegany Counties. Estimated cost of the three soil test projects total \$397,900.

One project provides for 302 borings along approximately 21 miles of the future expressway route from Salamanca easterly to Allegany, Cattaraugus County. Estimated cost of this project is \$125,000.

Another job specifies 204 test borings along 11.1 miles of the route from Allegany northeasterly to Hinsdale, Cattaraugus County. Its estimated cost is \$200,400.

The third project calls for 84 test borings along 6.6 miles of the route from Hinsdale northeasterly to Cuba, in Allegany County. Cost of this job is estimated at \$62,500.

Soil tests are carried out as a preliminary step to the final design of a new highway segment. Findings help determine exact locations of roadways, types of drainage structures needed and other data required by engineers for highway design details.

The bids will be opened publicly by the State Department of Public Works and the work carried out under the jurisdiction of the DPW Bureau of Soil Mechanics, the Department's District 5 Office in Buffalo and District Engineer Norman W. Krapp.

**Common Errors Delay Refunds**

Common errors in filing Federal tax returns complicate the processing of taxpayers' refunds, said John E. Foley, District Director of Internal Revenue at Buffalo.

Simple errors on returns delay refunds and cause taxpayers trouble. Mr. Foley suggests this simple checklist:

1. Check arithmetic.
2. Attach all Forms W-2.
3. Sign your return. (Both husband and wife should sign a joint return).
4. Print or type name and address, and write figures plainly.
5. Use correct tax table.
6. Total your deductions if you itemize on page 2.
7. List your Social Security number correctly. (Both husband's and wife's number should be reported on joint return).

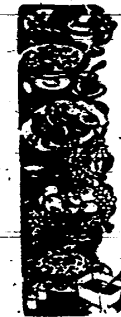
