In an order effective May 3, the board gave Mohawk authority for a three-year period to provide a non-stop service between Elmira-Corning and Washington-Philadelphia. The CAB suspended, for a three-year period, the authority of United Air Lines to serve Elmira-Corning and Harrisburg and Williamsport, Pa., on its route between Buffalo, N. Y. and Philadelphia and Washington.

United retains its authority to operate between Buffalo and Philadelphia, Washington and Baltimore by way of Rochester.
