The Thelma Rogers Geneological & Historical Society has purchased the Dyke St. engine house on East Dyke St., Wellsville and plans to establish a museum in the former fire hall. The Dyke St. company has moved into new quarters at Hanover and Osborne. Representative of six towns — Wellsville, Andover, Independence, Scio Alma and Willing banded together to form the nucleus of the society some seven years ago. The society is named for the late Thelma Lewis Rogers, an elementary school teacher who devoted much time to geneological research. The society hopes it might open the museum in the fall.
