Charles C. Whiting Graduates From OCS

Charles C. Whiting, a former Andover resident and son of Mr. and Mrs. Douglas Whiting, received his diploma from the Oklahoma National Guard Officer Candidate School Sunday afternoon in Oklahoma City's Northwest Classen High School auditorium.

Major General L. E. Weber, adjutant general of Oklahoma, presented diplomas to a group of 233 officer candidates - the largest number by far in the ten-year history of the Oklahoma National Guard Officer Candidate School.

Lt. Whiting graduated from Advanced Tech in 1960 and then at-

tended Michigan State University for 3 years before entering the Army on active duty in Sept. 1963.

He received his basic training at Fort Knox, Kentucky and was then transferred to Fort Sill, Okla.

Since completing his tour of active duty in the Army, he has been working in Lawton, Okla., for the past three years and has remained in the active Reserve.

Last fall he entered the OCS training program in the Oklahoma National Guard and underwent an accelerated training program, and on the successful completion of the course, has received his Commission as a 2nd Lt. in the active reserves.
