



SOCIAL NOTES

The Hornell Common Council approved a leash law for the control of dogs in the city to take effect immediately. No person owning or having custody and control of a dog shall permit such dog to be at large in the City of Hornell.

The Steuben County Fair will be held as scheduled Aug. 22 - 28 despite a fire that caused \$100,000 damage to the Bath Fair Grounds early Monday morning. The fire of undetermined cause, burned the 2,000-seat grandstand to the ground, destroyed the ticket office and a two-story judges' stand, and burned about half of the stage.

In the wake of a sudden electrical storm Wednesday lightning struck a three-story barn belonging to Nate Tucker of 122 North Main St., in Alfred. The building burned to the ground.

Approximately 180 persons took part Saturday in the 43rd annual Old Timers' Day activities, including election of officers for 1966, election of officers for 1967, Park and a banquet at the Friendship Central School. Fire destroyed the mill of the Holland Lumber Co., on North Main St., Hornell, Monday night doing damage estimated at \$10,000 to \$50,000. Four fire companies and more than 100 firemen battled the blaze that erupted in towering flames at 10:15 p. m. The intense heat drove firemen back at first, and two were injured. It broke the windshield and melted the dome light on one fire truck. But within an hour the fire-fighters had it under control, and had saved a home less than 20 feet from the burning mill.
