### Advisory Committee On Ambulance Services To Meet In Albany Today

A newly formed Advisory Committee on Ambulance Services will meet Thursday (Oct. 6) to assist in drafting regulations for the administration of a new ambulance control law. Dr. Rollis S. Ingraham, State Health Commissioner, announced.

The meeting will be at 2 p. m. in Room 200 of the Health Department in Albany.

The new law, which becomes effective Jan. 1, exempts the 1,932 volunteer ambulance services in the State. It unanimously passed both houses of the Legislature and became Chapter 949 of the Laws of 1966.

Governor Rockefeller, in a letter to Dr. Ingraham on September 29 said he was "particularly interested to see that provision is made for funeral directors who have furnished such important ambulance services to localities where there has been no other ambulance service available."

In a reply to the Governor, Dr. Ingraham called the law "basically sound legislation" that is designed to provide medical emergency services of the highest quality for the people of New York State.

Dr. Ingraham noted that, "It is

possible that many of the present services, such as those provided by funeral directors, the continuance of which has been a source of concern in some communities, may not be covered by the present law."

Governor Rockefeller asked that the new advisory panel "be broadly representative." Dr. Ingraham reported to the Governor that, to ensure this, representatives of the major groups involved, including funeral directors, would be asked to serve on the Committee.

Consumer representatives, including the New York State Grange and the New York Farm Bureau have been invited to serve, Dr. Ingraham told the Governor.

"We have frankly been disturbed over what we believe to be misunderstandings in some communities over the intent and provisions of the law," Dr. Ingraham said.

"We are most anxious to administer the new law," the Commissioner told the Governor, "so as to provide the highest quality of emergency medical service without causing hardship for either the providers or consumers of this essential service."
