**Purple And White**

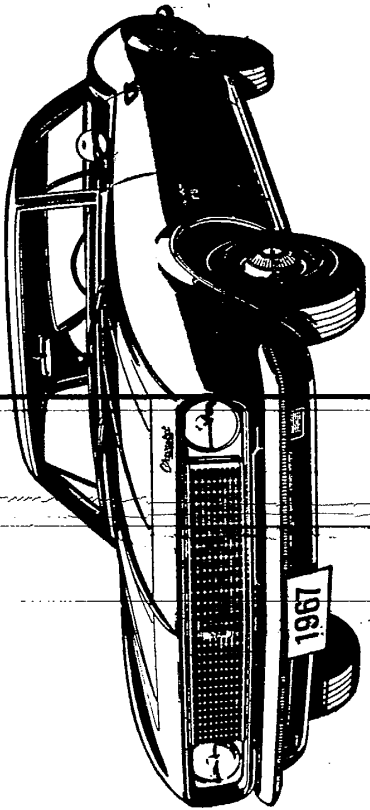
