Awarding of a \$10,000 Federal grant for the development of additional facilities on the Almond Dam Recreation Area in Steuben County has been announced by the Northeast Regional Director of the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, Rolland B. Handley. Plans call for additions to the water and electrical systems, permanent sanitary facilities and the installation of playground apparatus. Existing facilities include a 125 acre flood control impoundment, bathing beach, bathing house, tent and trailer campsites, picnic areas, parking areas and interior roads.

Allegany County Board of Supervisors, with only one dissenting vote, Thursday adopted a tentative

1967 budget of \$5,256,074.22, \$3.71 per \$1,000 assessed valuation — from \$16.94 to \$20.65, which would raise real estate taxes. The budget goes to public hearing in the courthouse here at 7:30 p. m. Thursday, Nov. 10th. After the vote, Supervisor Raymond Kopler of the Town of Huron, chairman of the Sales Tax Committee, asked the board to study again a sales tax that might lift some of the burden from real property owners. In a show of hands, 11 supervisors favored immediate sales tax action but 16 wanted to postpone action.
