Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Allegany will meet at the Supervisors' Chambers in the Courthouse in Belmont, New York, at 2:30 p. m., on the 14th day of November, 1966, for the purpose of holding a public hearing on the tentative budget of said County for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1967.

Further notice is hereby given that copies of said tentative budget will be available at the Office of the Clerk of said Board of Supervisors at the Courthouse where they may be inspected or procured by an interested person during business hours.

Pursuant to Section 359 of the County law the maximum per diem to be paid during the coming year to members of the Board of Supervisors shall not exceed \$40 for regular and special meetings and shall not exceed \$20 for special committee meetings. In addition to the per diem the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall receive an annual salary of \$1,500.
