**All Model Cars Must Be Inspected Before January**

Beginning with December expirations, all cars and trucks, regardless of their model year, must have passed the State's periodic safety inspection before their registrations may be renewed, County Clerk Helen S. Ackerman explained to residents of Allegany County today.

Mrs. Ackerman pointed out that she will accept renewal applications provided the car to be registered in December bears an inspection sticker and the renewal stub from the present registration has been stamped by an inspection station indicating that the safety-check was made since last January.

This also applies to registrations which expire in January, February and March. The inspection must have been passed within the previous 12 months. For example: a car whose registration expires in January must have been checked since last February; a February expiration requires an inspection sometime since last March, etc.

Vehicles older than 1961 models came under the old schedule of inspections and therefore already have complied with the law and need not be inspected previous to renewal of the registrations in December, January, February and March.

Newer models, however, must have the inspection stamp on the renewal stub of the present registration.

**Livestock Survey To Be Made**

Rural Mail Carriers of the Andover Post Office distributed December Livestock Survey cards to farmer patrons along their routes about November 23, Postmaster Rita E. Burns announced today.

This survey is one of three in which the Post Office Department

assists the U. S. Department of Agriculture each year. Some 21,000 questionnaire cards for the current survey will be distributed to farmers throughout New York State.

The present year marks the one-hundredth anniversary of Federal crop and livestock reports, and rural carrier surveys have been carried on for more than 40 years. The survey cards are to be returned by December 2nd.

Livestock cards returned by farmers to their carriers will be forwarded to the New York Crop Reporting Service in Albany. There the information will be summarized to show changes in livestock numbers on Empire State farms. Estimates will also be made of the 1966 calf crop and pig crop and of livestock death and farm slaughter during the year.
