attitude and achievement in Home-making. It was divided into two sections, the first part being objective and the second being written. The total time for the exam was one hour.

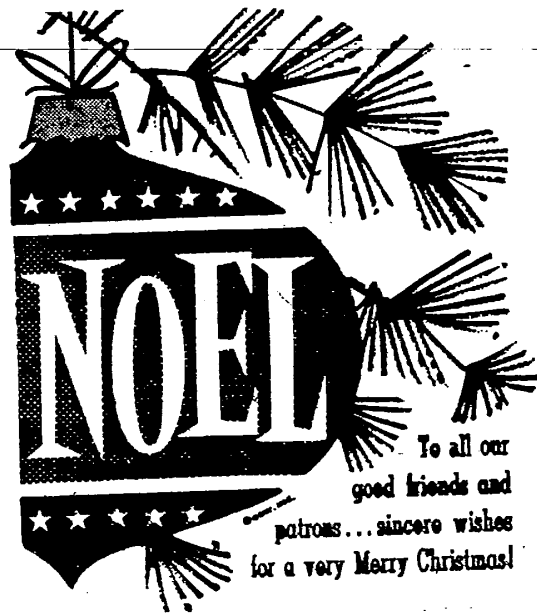
The exam was on a competitive
