Pfc. E-3, Lyle L. Ostrander, son of Mr. and Mrs. Lyle Ostrander, Proctor Terrace, Wellsville, returned home January 18th after serving a one-year tour of overseas duty with the Combat Engineers in Vietnam.

Lyle and Jack Hunt of Andover, entered service Aug. 9, 1965 and received their Basic Training in Ft. Dix, N. J., together. However, the boys were separated when Lyle went into Advanced Combat Engineer Training and was shipped to Vietnam two weeks ahead of Jack.
