Louis Goldberg To Speak At County Mental Health Meeting

Louis Goldberg, Associate Mental Health Representative of the New York State Department of Mental Hygiene — Division of Mental Health Service (Rochester office), will address a membership meeting of the Allegany County Mental Health Association, at 8:00 p. m. Wednesday, February 8 at Howell Hall in Alfred.

Mr. Goldberg represents the state department responsible for helping communities develop and support their own mental health programs, for which state aid is available. The Division of Mental Health Service is the part of the State Department of Mental Hygiene charged with implementing the Community Mental Health Service Act of 1964, which provided that a county or community having a Mental Health Board may qualify for up to 50% reimbursement for expenses of an approved mental health program.

Prior to his appointment in 1963 to his present position, Mr. Goldberg served ten years as chief psychiatric social worker at Buffalo Children's Hospital, Child Guidance Clinic. Still earlier in his career, Mr. Goldberg with the Philadelphia Child Guidance Clinic. He has taught and lectured extensively, and until recently he held a lecturing position with the State University of New York at Buffalo Department of Sociology, School of Social Work.

The Rochester office to which Mr. Goldberg is attached is headquarters for coordinating community mental health services in 17 counties, including the 5 in the Buffalo Region. Mr. Goldberg has been instrumental in securing Mental Health Boards and establishing services to be administered under those boards in many neighboring counties, including Cattaraugus, Chautauque, Wyoming and Steuben. He is a member of the New York State Planning Committee on Mental Disorders, and is thus in a position to inform us of the latest developments in planning for additional facilities and services in our area.
