Mr. Goldberg represents the state department responsible fin helping communities develop and support their own mental heatth programs, for which state aid is available. The Division of Mental Health Sevice is the part of the State Department of Mental Hygiene charged with implementing the community Mental Health Service Act of 1964, which provided that a county or community having a Mental Health Board may qualify for up to 50% reimburse ment for expenses of an approved mental health program.
