 A. Ingersoll and George B. Harris,
 Jr., being all of the Directors of
 Tullar Field Association, Inc., let
 the Attorney General of the State
 of New York, the members, cred-
 itors and contributors to the funds
 of said Association, and such other
 persons, firms and corporations as
 may be interested in these pro-
 ceedings show cause before this
