The boy, Daniel Starr, 10, of Waterloo, using the worm as bait, reeled in an 11-pound 13-ounce rainbow Saturday at Naples Creek, just south of Canandaigua lake in the Finger Lakes region. The catch was good enough to earn second place, a youth award and \$90 in the Naples Creek Fish Derby.

Daniel was one of 4,000 at Naples Creek who tried their luck on the opening day of the trout season in the state.

Robert Summer of West Seneca, a Buffalo suburb, hooked a 13-pound, 9-ounce, rainbow which earned him a first place trophy and \$100 in the Naples Creek Derby.

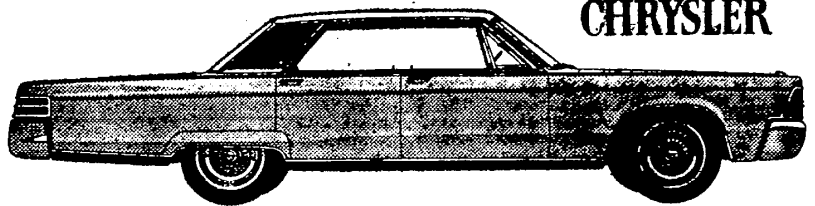

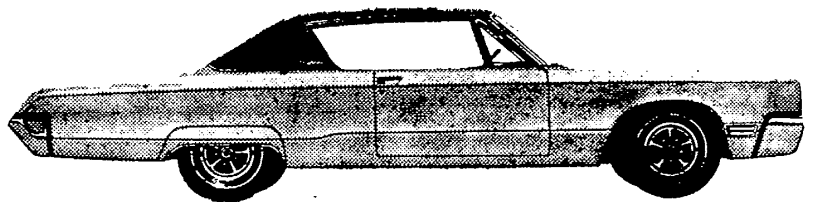

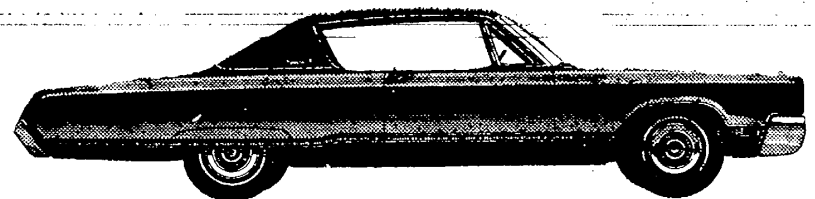
