Proclamation By The Governor

Governor Rockefeller has designated April as "Cancer Education Month" in a proclamation ampealing for the continued publiq support he said "is vital so that intensive year-round additional activities can be maintained to reduce cancer's toll."

Citing an estimated 60,000 new cancer cases in New York State this year and the "grim toll" of more than 38,000 who will die of the disease, the Governor said:

"There are some 1,400,000 Americans alive today cured of cancer. O'uly a few years ago, one cancer patient in four was being cured. Today, it is one in every three victims. With the tools and knowledge available right now, this figure could be reduced to one in two if more people visited their physician at the first appearance of any of cancer's seven warning signals.

"Much is being done in our

"Much is heing done in our State by dedicated and devoted medical scientists, physicians, voluntary health agencies and public health departments to combat this disease. Because cancer when detected and treated early is curable portland support of the battle against this dread disease by the critizens of our State is vital so that intensive year round additional activities can be maintained to reduce cancer's toll."
