Notice Of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that a
Public Hearing will be held con-
cerning a Local Law to provide
for weighted voting by members
of the Board of Supervisors of the
County of Allegany in the Super-
visors' room at the County Court-
house in Belmont, New York, at
7:30 o'clock P. M. May 10, 1967.
The proposed Local Law is as
follows:

"SECTION ONE: On and after
January 1, 1968, there shall be 29
members of the Board of Super-
visors of the County of Allegany.
These 29 members, who shall be
the duly elected Town Supervis-
ors, shall represent the 29 towns
situated in the County of Allegany.
All matters voted upon by said
Supervisors shall be done by
weighted voting as hereafter de-
termined except that on any com-
mittee each Supervisor shall have
one vote.

SECTION TWO: a. The Sup-
ervisor of each town shall be en-
titled to a number of votes equal
to the quotient, in whole number
obtained by dividing the citizen
population in each town by 142,
provided that any such calculation
leaving a remainder quotient of
72 or more shall entitle each such
Supervisor to one more vote.
Citizen population for each town
shall be the same as the cen-
sation population for each town as de-
termined by the 1960 Federal
Decennial Census, except that
1,463 shall be the citizen popula-
tion for the Town of Alfred and
1,274 shall be the citizen popula-
tion for the Town of Canadadea.

ing, the assignment of votes to
the Supervisors of the respective

SECTION THREE: A total of
145 affirmative votes shall be re-
quired for the adoption of any
resolution, local law, motion or
proposal requiring a majority vote
and total of 192 affirmative votes
shall be required for the adoption
of any resolution requiring a two-
thirds vote.

SECTION FOUR: This Local
Law shall become effective Janu-
ary 1, 1968, only after favorably
voted upon by the electors of
Allegany County at the General
Election to be held November 7,
1967."
