Don Rosen Named General Chairman of Cystic Fibrosis Drive

Cystic Fibrosis Research Foundation of Western New York County is proud to state that Don Rosen has accepted General Chairmanship for the forthcoming drive September 17 to September 24th, 1967. Mr. Rosen served in this capacity in 1966 at which time the drive was only conducted in Erie County.

Cystic Fibrosis is an inherited chemical disorder at internal error of metabolism affecting the glands of external secretion, notably the mucous and sweat glands. It is one of the most common and serious chronic diseases of childhood, the leading cause of death between age 10 and 20, and a leading cause of death in adults.

The disease is characterized by chronic coughing, wheezing, and frequent infections of the lungs. It is a progressive disease and eventually leads to death.

Incubation of the disease is a matter of a few years, but it is not inherited by parents. It is not contagious. The disease is not a result of poor diet or lack of exercise. It is a genetic disease. Both parents must be carriers of the disease can only children inherit it in 400 families. The disease can have as many as 1, 2, 3, or 4 children with the disease. About 10 percent will be carriers, and possibly the balance of the children will be free from the gene. It is not contagious.

Cystic Fibrosis is a real cancer, outbreaks, pneumonia, liver and polio before the advent of vaccine as a cause of death in babies and children.

There is no known cure. Survival of the disease of children and their chances to live depend on a broad application of accumulated knowledge, expert medical care and adequate provision of other essential services, expensive drugs and equipment.

Research is of vital importance if science can determine recognition of these disastrous genes, there is possibly a chance to control Cystic Fibrosis.

So we are asking everyone to help all those now suffering and those yet to be discovered, by assisting in our 1967 campaign. Tomorrow it could be you — or your relative or friend. Many people have had normal healthy children, then finally have C F children, so who knows how it begins — who is a carrier? Are you?

We must try to put a stop to all the innocent little children dying and suffering with C F — just as they did with polio. It took millions before a discovery was made and it will take millions to find our answer. Do not dodge your responsibility — but let's help cleanse the world of bodily diseases by pushing health with our

Fertilizer Tonnage Hits High, 655,000

New York farmers produced more food on a diminishing number of agricultural acres may be explained in the first summary of fertilizer tonnages issued by the Department of Agriculture and Markets.

Under a new law the Department requires a fee payment based on the amount of business a fertilizer distributor does within the borders of New York State. The law also requires the Commissioner of Agriculture and Markets to publish a fertilizer digest.

The first such figures show the 1955 distribution of fertilizer, valued at \$1.5 billion, to their few customers. In 1956, 84 percent of the amount went to farmers.

From 1955 to 1966, the total amount of fertilizer used in New York State increased by 67 percent. The most popular grade was in the 10-10-10, 10-20-20 and 5-10-10 classifications of nitrogen, phosphate and potash.

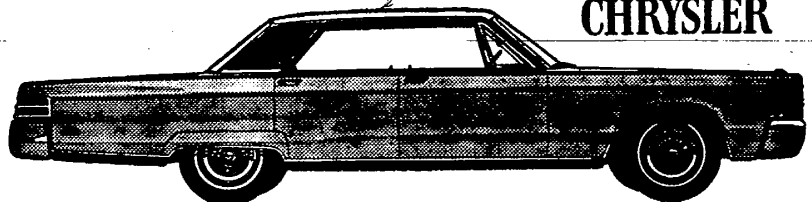

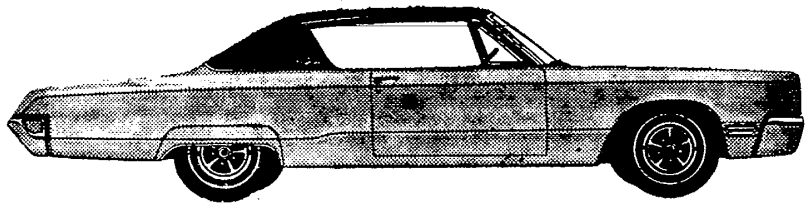

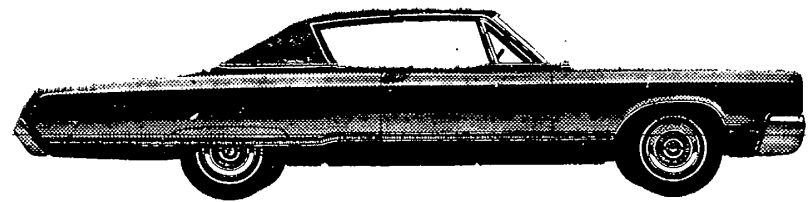
