CURFEW ORDINANCE
Sec. 1. — It shall be unlawful
for any child under the age of 16 or any child under the age of 16 years to be or remain upon any of the streets, avenues or alleyr of the Village of Andover, N. Y. at any time after nine o'clock P. M., unless such child is accompanied by its parent or guardian or by some adult person.

Sec. 2. — A Police Officer or

Sec. 2. — A Police Officer or Constable of said Village designated by the Board of Trustees of said village at and on each and every day at 9:00 P. M. shall sound or cause to be sounded an alarm in said village which shall be known as the Curfew Alarm.

Sec. 3.—(a) This ordinance shall not apply to any child or children in search of a physician provided such child or children at the time of being found upon the street is actually executing such errand (b) or to any child or children who may be upon the streets of said Village who shall have in his possession a written of printed permit signed and dated by the parent or guardian or person having legal custody of such minor person dated in ink for the day it is to be used, which said permit shall state that the said minor person is absent from home for some necessary purpose. But, in order that the said permit shall exempt such minor person from arrest on the evening for which it is dated, the said minor person shall not be found unnecessarily loitering or playing upon any of the streets, avenues or alleys or public prem ises of the Village.

## Does Your Driver's License Expire In November

About one million New York State motor vehicles registrations expire at the end of November.

Consequently, the Department of Motor Vehicles suggests that you check your own registration to see if it is among those marked for November 30 expiration.

The owners affected should have received their punch card renewal applications by now, since they were mailed from Albany several weeks ago The Department urges that they be completed and either mailed or brought to the issuing office nearest the owner's residence as soon as possible.

dence as soon as possible.

If an owner does mail his renewal to a local office — and this is the correct procedure in most cases — he should be sure to include the renewal stub from his present registration, proof that he has complied with the inspection law, the name of his insurance company (not the agent), and the fee as printed on the application.

He also must sign the application in three places — on the back of Part 1 and the front of Parts 3 and 4. Owners do forget to sign, the Department says, particularly on the back of Page 1.

It is possible, for one reason or another, that some owners have not received the application by now. In this event, they should obtain a paper application from their local office and use that. It also is possible that the office may have the punch card application, if the postman could not deliver it to the owner's home.
