Free Trees Available For 4-H Club Members
4-H members over 12 years of age who have not previously received more than 2000 free trees through the Conservation Department are eligible to apply for 1000 seedlings for spring delivery. The trees are free except for transportation cost but must be planted on the land of a close relative, namely, parents, foster parents, uncle, aunt or brother. Club members should understand that trees can be ordered only twice in lots of 1000 each for a total of not over 2000 trees during their 4-H Club career. This total of 2000 may be ordered either through 4-H or Vocational Ag, but may not exceed 1000 trees per year, nor a total of the 2000 trees from both sources, during the period enrolled in 4-H or Vocational Ag.
Species available are White Spruce, Norway Spruce, Scotch Pine, Japanese Larch, all of which are in good supply for those who order early.
Boys and girls in Allegany County interested in the future forest project, should request a tree order form now from the 4-H office, Belmont, and return it promptly for consideration.

Ft. Polk, La. — Army Private John (Steve) Baker, 19, son of Mr. and Mrs. John E. Baker, 7 Maple St. Andover, N. Y., completed nine weeks of advanced infantry training Nov. 10 at Ft. Polk, La. His last week of training was spent in guerrilla warfare exercises. During his guerrilla training, he lived under simulated Vietnam conditions for five days, fighting off night attacks and conducting raids on "enemy" villages. He was taught methods of removing booby traps, setting ambushes and avoiding enemy ambushes. Other specialized training included small unit tactics, map reading, land mine warfare, communications and firing the M-14 rifle M-60 machinegun and the 3.5-inch rocket launcher.
