HOSPITAL NOTES

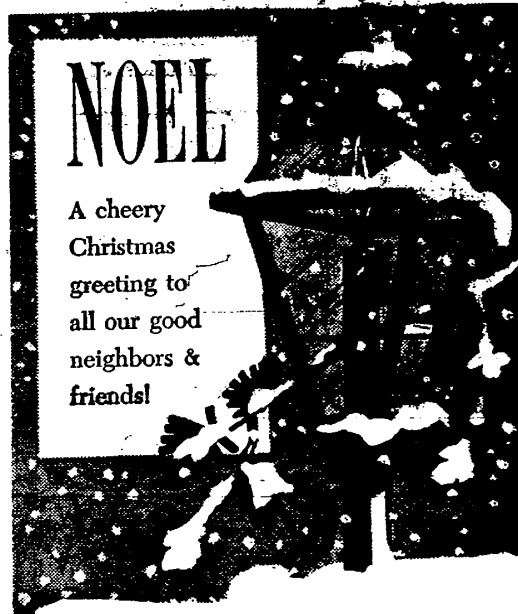
Lawrence Corwin was admitted to the North Side General Hospital in Rochester Monday as a surgical patient.

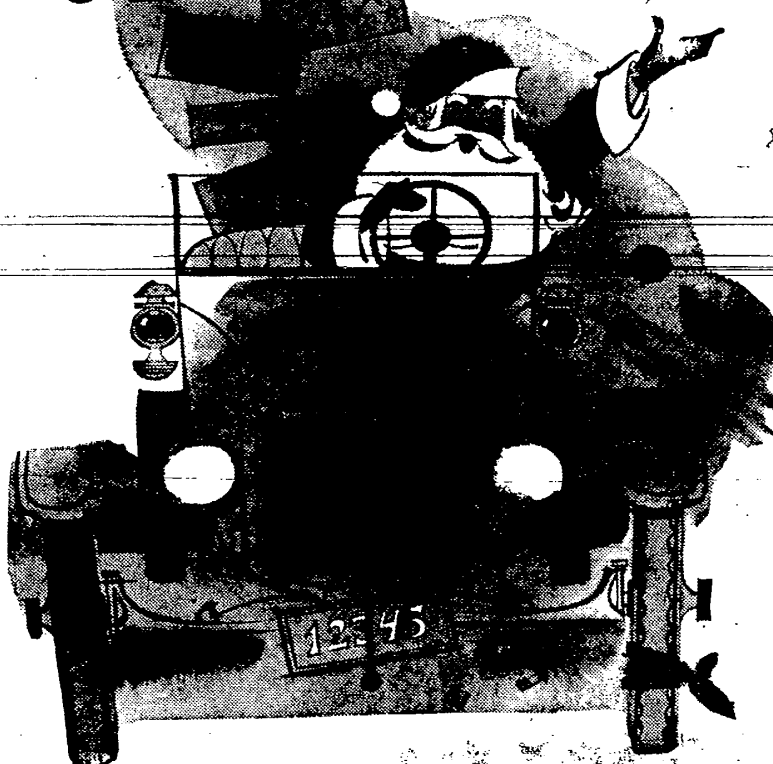
