In addition, he has conducted bassoon and band clinics and is a member of the Ithaca Woodwind Quintet.

Professor Fote is no stranger to Alfred State College since he not only is an alumnus but wrote the school's alma mater. He went on to obtain a B.S. decree in music education at Fredonia and an M.A. from the University of Rochester. He has had several arrangements and compositions for band mublished.
