

Andover To Participate In Band Festival At Alfred

A total of 19 bands from area schools will be performing at the first annual Band Festival scheduled for Friday and Saturday, (March 29 - 30) at State University Agricultural and Technical College at Alfred.

Judging the performances of each band during the event will be Dr. Kenneth Snapp, director of the Ithaca College concert band, and Edward J. Gobrecht Jr., instructor of bassoon and director of the training band at Ithaca College.

A special workshop for band directors is also planned and will be in charge of Richard Fote, professor of sax, brass and theory at State University College at Fredonia, and Professor Joseph Canale, director of instrumental music at the host college. They will be assisted by the two adjudicators.

Professor Snapp, who was awarded his master's degree in music from the University of Michigan, earned his Ph.D. in 1963 at Indiana University. For 14 summers, he was director of bands and a teacher of brass instruments at the National Music Camp at Interlochen, Mich.

Professor Gobrecht has played professionally with several symphony orchestras and has traveled extensively throughout New York and the Eastern United States directing all-county and area all-state bands. In addition, he has conducted bassoon and band clinics and is a member of the Ithaca Woodwind Quintet.

Professor Fote is no stranger to Alfred State College since he not only is an alumnus but wrote the school's alma mater. He went on to obtain a B.S. degree in music education at Fredonia and an M. A. from the University of Rochester. He has had several arrangements and compositions for band published.

Professor Canale has had 15 years experience in public school music and is now completing his second year at Alfred State College. He holds both a B.S. and M.S. degree in music education

from Ithaca College and has been a guest conductor at numerous music festivals.

The two latest schools to join the music event are Lancaster Senior High School and Iroquois Central School, while two which have withdrawn from the festival because of schedule conflicts are Pine Valley Central School and Birchmont Park Collegiate Institute of Scarborough, Ontario, Canada.

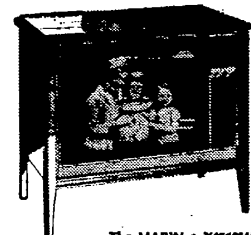
