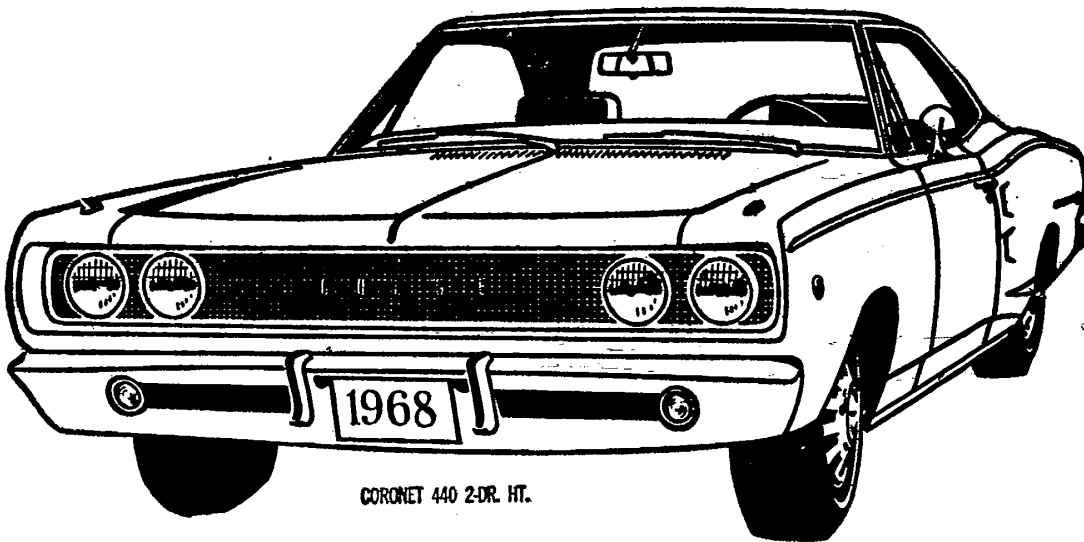

Cathy Swartz was Third. She came at 7:15 a. m.

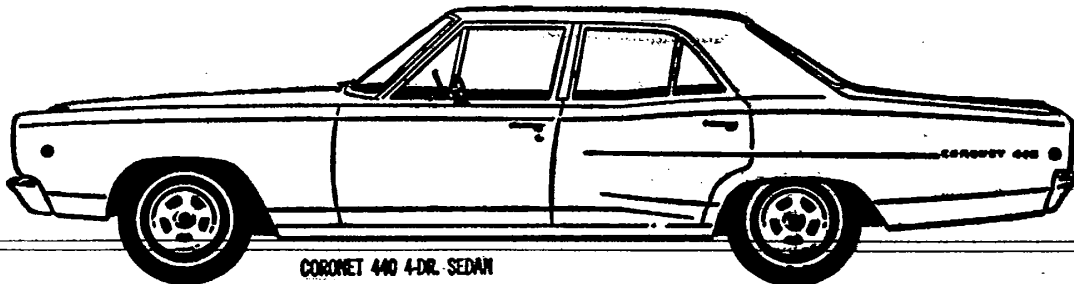

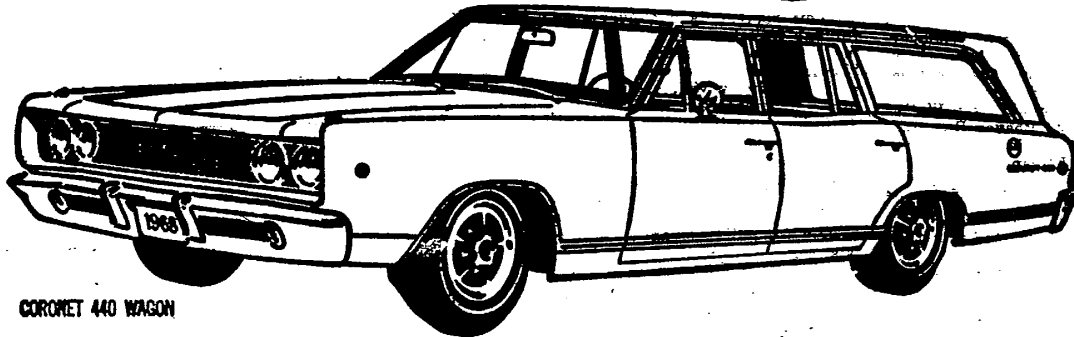
