A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR WEIGHTED VOTING BY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ALLEGANY ON AN INTERIM BASIS PURSUANT TO THE UNITED STATES AND STATE OF NEW YORK CONSTITUTIONS AND AN ORDER OF THE NEW YORK STATE SUPREME COURT.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Allegany as follows:
