Legal Notice

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT LOCAL LAW NO. 3 of 1968 was filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on August 6, and became effective in accordance with its provisions. The text of the law is as follows:

A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR WEIGHTED VOTING BY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ALLEGANY COUNTY ON AN INTERIM BASIS PURSUANT TO THE UNITED STATES AND STATE OF NEW YORK CONSTITUTIONS AND AN ORDER OF THE NEW YORK STATE SUPREME COURT.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Allegany as follows:

SECTION ONE: Each of the twenty-nine members of the Board of Supervisors of Allegany County shall be entitled to cast at each special and regular meeting of the Allegany County Board of Supervisors the number of votes set forth opposite their respective towns as follows:

SECTION TWO: A total of 575 affirmative votes shall be required for the adoption of any resolution, local law, motion or proposal requiring a majority vote, and a total of 766 affirmative votes shall be required for the adoption of any resolution requiring a two-thirds vote.

SECTION THREE: The number of supervisors whose combined vote will equal at least a majority vote shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but members with a lesser combination may adjourn.

SECTION FOUR: This Local Law shall become effective August 1, 1968, if prior approval is given by an Order of the New York State Supreme Court, and shall remain in effect until January 1, 1970, unless either terminated sooner or extended further by law of by an Order of the New York State Supreme Court.
