Delayed By Strike, Dog Licensing Gets Going In December

Get your dog licensed before January 1, says the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets, and avoid all the headaches involved in retrieving him if he is taken to the pound.

Although the Department is primarily a consumer service agency, supervision of dog licensing outside of New York City is one of many tasks assigned to it by law. And the law says any dog without a license on January 1 shall be taken by officers regardless of whether he is on or off his owner's premises.

A strike in the contract paper mill held up the printing of 1969 dog licenses so long that deliveries to the issuing offices of city and town clerks — and village clerks in a few instances — were delayed up to three months.

The Dog Licensing Bureau in Agriculture and Markets says, however, that every clerk will have his full complement of licensing material by early Decem-

ber. Many clerks already have thousands of license applications on hand ready for processing. Nothing in the dog law gives any issuing clerk or any peace officer the right to extend or overlook the January 1 deadline.

Alfred University To Launch Building Program

Alfred University will launch and 11 Million Dollar Building Program in the spring, the largest program in the 132 year history of the University.

The announcement was made by University President Leland Miles after receiving word from Albany that the New York State Dormitory Authority had authorized a \$5 million bond issue for capital improvements at Alfred. An additional \$1 million has been raised from Federal funds and private sources. The remaining \$5 million has been provided by the State University of New York (SUNY) for expansion of SUNY College of Ceramics at Alfred University.

The program calls for the construction of seven new buildings on the campus of the University and the renovation of an eighth. The overall building project is the second stage of a ten year construction effort by the University.

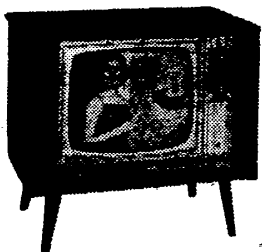
