**Notice Of Public Hearing**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held in the County Supervisors' room at the County Courthouse, Belmont, New York, on Wednesday, December 18, 1968, at 7:30 o'clock P. M., in connection with a proposed Local Law for the County of Allegany in the event of an attack or public disaster.

The proposed Local Law provides for the continuity of the government of the County of Allegany by requiring that each elective and appointive officer designate, in addition to any duly authorized deputy, an emergency interim successor to act in the place of such officer in the event of an attack or public disaster when such officer or his duly authorized deputy is unable or unavailable to act during such time. The Local Law further provides

for the qualifications, manner of selection, status, and powers and duties of such emergency interim successor; the performance of such office without compensation, except for actual expenses necessarily incurred; the recording and publication of designations and the suspension by the Chairmen of the Board of Supervisors or his emergency interim successor of the quorum requirements of the Board of Supervisors in the event of an attack or public disaster. If such quorum is suspended, the Local Law provides that any local law or resolution may be enacted by an affirmative vote of those supervisors voting thereon.

Such Local Law, if adopted, shall take effect upon its adoption and the filing of one certified copy thereof with the County Clerk, one certified copy in the office of the state comptroller and three certified copies in the office of the secretary of state.
