Fund-Raising Activities Must File Reports

All charitable organizations in New York State which raise more than \$25,000 a year or pay any person for fund-raising activities must now file expanded uniform financial reports.

This new rule was adopted on January 21 by the State Board of Social Welfare at its, January meeting in Albany. It implements action taken by the Legislature at its 1968 session.

Commenting on the new requirement, Board Chairman Hugh R. Jones said, "It will now enable the Department of Social Services to provide the contributing public with comparable data on similar charities asking for support."

According to Mr. Jones, more

According to Mr. Jones, more than two-thirds of the 5,000 charthan two-thirds of the 5,000 charitable organizations registered with the State Department of Social Services will be affected by the new rule. In annual reports, filed on forms prescribed by the Department, these organizations will now have to provide more details on both income and expenditures. Income schedules will tails on both income and expenditures. Income schedules will show various sources of funds by categories, and the fund-raising expense involved in obtaining contributions. Expenditure schedules will show amounts spent on specific programs as well as on salaries, awards and grants, and professional fees.

These reports will also contain a balance sheet disclosing the organization's assets, liabilities, and the balance of each of its funds. Each report will be certified by an authorized officer of the charitable organization and by its

an authorized officer of the charitable organization and by its chief fiscal officer. It will also contain an independent public accountant's opinion that the financial operations and position of the organization.

Those charitable organizations not subject to the new rules because they raise less than \$25,000 and because their fund-raising is performed by volunteers still must file short-form financial reports with the department.

A number of conferences are now being planned for various parts of the State so that charitable organizations affected get additional help on complying with the new rules.
